- **12.'Pros and cons'** refers to the advantages and disadvantages of a situation, helping in decision-making by weighing positive and negative aspects.
- **13.'Safe and sound'** means being unharmed and in good condition, often used to reassure someone about another's well-being after a journey or event.
- **14.'Back and forth'** describes a repetitive movement or exchange, like a conversation or pacing. It's commonly used to describe discussions or physical movements.
- **15.'Like chalk and cheese'** means two things are completely different from each other. For example: Although they're twins, their personalities are like chalk and cheese one's outgoing and the other's very shy."
