i 'Mood' changes the initial 'm' to 'w', maintaining the rest of the letters. This type of variation can be found in word puzzles.

2. Change the **bold underlined letter** in the word 'lead' by another one from the list to form a new word.

i 'Lead' differs from 'leaf' by changing the 'd' to 'f'. This type of word play is common in rhyming games and enhances language skills.

i 'Word' becomes 'worn' by changing 'd' to 'n', showing a simple one-letter alteration. Remember 'worn' is the past participle of the verb 'wear', e.g. 'I have worn this coat way too much, it is about time I buy a new one'

i 'Dear' turns into 'deer' by altering 'a' to e', illustrating the concept of minimal changes resulting in different words. E.g. 'Many children saw in Bambi the deer a dear friend'.

i 'Boat' is different from 'coat' by changing 'b' to 'c', demonstrating how changing a single letter can lead to a new word.

i 'Bore' is one letter different from 'bone' by changing 'n' to 'r'. E.g. 'I wouldn't like to bore you with a long story which could be boring, so let me go to the point instead'.

Two new words by changing the **bold underlined letter** in the word 'hill' by two different letters from the list.

i 'Hill' turns into 'hall' and 'hull' by only changing the vowel. 'Hall' is the area just inside the main entrance of a house, apartment, or other building that leads to other rooms and usually to the stairs. 'Hull' is the body or frame of a ship, most of which goes under the water (picture)

9. Change the **bold underlined letter** in the word 'lamp' by another one from the list to form a new word.

i 'Lamp' turns into 'lump' by replacing 'a' with 'u'. A lump is a piece of a solid substance, and could have no particular shape, e.g. sugar lump. It is also a hard swelling found in or on the body, especially because of illness or injury.

i 'Base' turns into 'case' by changing only the consonant 'b' to 'c'. A case is a particular situation or a container to store things.

i 'Pale' differs from 'pole' by changing 'a' to 'o'. A 'pole' is a long, thin stick of wood or metal, often used standing straight up in the ground to support things, e.g. 'the electricity pole'

i 'Stop' changes to 'step' by altering 'o' to 'e', displaying a common method to form new words through minor changes.
