i The correct answer is 'will be' because this is a first conditional sentence referring to a real and possible situation in the future.

i The correct answer is 'had caught' because it refers to an unreal past situation, using the third conditional structure.

i The correct answer is 'had been' as this is a third conditional sentence, referring to an unreal past situation.

i The correct answer is 'get'. This is a zero conditional sentence which refers to a general truth.

8. She would buy the book ___ we told her not to. In such case, we should buy it later then.

i 'Unless' means except if/ if not. It fits as it expresses the only condition under which the statement changes. Example: 'I will go unless it rains.' (except if it rains)

9. If we ____ more time for this project, we would have better results. Unfortunately, we didn't have that time.

i The correct answer is 'had had'. It refers to an unreal condition in past 'if we had had more time' linked to a present hypothetical situation 'we would have'. It is an example of a mixed conditional.

i The correct answer is 'would have helped', as it refers to an unreal past condition using the third conditional.

i Inversion is used in conditionals without 'if'. 'Had' begins this past hypothetical conditional. Example: Had I known, I would have acted differently.

i The correct answer is 'had studied' because this is a third conditional situation, referring to a past event that didn't occur.
