i The auxiliary 'will' is used for future actions. To disagree, 'will not' is the correct negation.

i The auxiliary 'have' indicates completion. To negate, use 'have not'.

**i** The auxiliary 'should' is used for suggestions. To disagree, use 'should not'.

**i** The auxiliary 'is' implies the current state. To disagree, use 'am not' if the subject is 'I'.

**i** To disagree, use 'were not' if the sentence has 'were'.

**i** The auxiliary 'might' expresses possibility. To disagree with this sentence, say 'might' because the sentence is in negative form.

**i** The auxiliary 'do' is used for emphasis. To negate, use 'do not'.

**i** 'Am' is the auxiliary for present action. To negate, use 'am not'.

**i** The auxiliary 'does' is used for emphasis in present simple. To negate, use 'does not'.

**i** 'Had' indicates past possession or experience. 'Did not' negates it.
